Sunday services will be live streamed from St John's at 10.30am each Sunday, including material recorded at St Britius. This streaming will be via both Zoom and Facebook watch party.




The link to the Zoom meeting will be posted on the Facebook pages of St John's Carterton and Friends of St Britius as well as on the St John's
