# A very Happy New Year to all Friends of St Britius

One year on from our first newsletter and who would have believed then that we would raise over £37,000 for "Stop the drips at St Brits" in that time: as we said in the Parish Newsletter, "beyond our wildest dreams!".

However, we must not get complacent as the task ahead is still daunting. Yes, we have been accepted by English Heritage to receive a grant, but it brings with it a time commitment to raise more funds.

## English Heritage Grant

The St Britius PCC have formally accepted the offer of a grant from English Heritage. Until EH have publicised that they are giving us a grant we cannot go into the details of the offer. However it is a grant towards the cost of repairs to the roof above the north aisle, vestry north slope and the chancel roof. We need to raise a further £40,000 to meet our share of the cost of this work. After this we will need to fund the cost of the nave and the porch roof.

## Donation from Air Tanker

We have now received the **£500** promised donation from Air Tanker for which we are very grateful.

#### Chrismas Bazaar

Many people braved the snow, ice and cold to be greeted in church by fairy lights, hot mulled wine, hot mince pies and sausage rolls and many stalls providing produce and Christmas gifts. It was a great atmosphere with everyone milling around and greeting friends as well as buying. Again a fantastic effort by the Fund Raising Team to organise the stalls and decorate the church which resulted in *£***509**.

These were sold at the Christmas Bazaar, but also at the Chequers, Masons Arms, Foxbury Farm, Timms, Brize Norton School Association Bazaar and in church. The Calenders raised **£136.40** and Christmas Cards **£70**.
