Budget and Parent Feedback on Provision

The School Council representative shared the views gathered from parent:

- Education City would not be missed the children have now lost excitement with the programme having used it a lot over the last 2 years.
- One parent said they did not feel there was any value in having artists and authors working in school. Many other parents disagreed with this view as they felt they enthused the children and enhanced school learning.
- Quality of education and opportunities that children are given is outstanding this was the view of a Year 6 parent.
