
## **FRIENDS OF ST BRITIUS**



## This leaflet explains the aims and objectives of the "Friends of St Britius".

Present and past residents of Brize Norton and those associated with the village and the nearby RAF Base appreciate the importance of the church within the village. The building has stood for nearly 1000 years and countless numbers have worshipped in the church on a regular basis, at our Special Services (Christmas, Easter, Harvest & Remembrance Services) and on Special Occasions: family christenings, weddings, memorial and funeral services. Friends of St Britius wish to preserve St Britius Church and ensure its future.

## **Friends of St Britius**

To be a "Friend of St Britius" you don't have to be a member of the Church of England, you simply value St Britius Church and its role in the life of Brize Norton.

If St Britius Church is to continue to function and play an important role in Brize Norton then we need to worry about a number of things, amongst which are:

- Having a roof over our heads
- A better heating system
- Ensuring the safety and future use of the bells
- Providing accommodation in the vestry for the Sunday Club
- Attracting more visitors to the Church
- Looking after the churchyard

We have been patching up the roof of the church, but now we need to do major work. Being a Grade 2\* listed building a new roof will require Cotswold Slates and will cost well in excess of £200,000. It is now too dangerous to ring the bells in church. The bell cage needs replacing in order to use the bells for services and weddings.

We are welcoming many more to the church with an increased number of weddings and in other ways. The Laying up of the RAF 99 Squadron Standard and the new side chapel cements our link with RAF Brize Norton. We want to open our church to all those associated with the RAF Base now and in the past. In doing so we will need volunteers to look after the church when it is open to visitors.

So with the Friends of St Britius we can not only communicate with but also involve a wider group of people who see and value the church building and keep them informed about the Church.
